ask students to reason, analyze, and explain:

- ✓ Compare and contrast
- ✓ Explain, reason, or understand why or how
- ✓ Give reasons, evidence, and examples
- ✓ Analyze, interpret, evaluate, or conclude
- ✓ Classify or categorize

SELF-EXPRESSIVE QUESTIONS

ask students to create and explore possibilities:

- ✓ Speculate (what if?), hypothesize, or predict
- ✓ Generate and explore alternatives
- ✓ Create or design something original
- ✓ Represent concepts visually/symbolically
- ✓ Develop and explore similes
